Assistive technology (AT) refers to assistive products, and their related systems and services. Assistive products can facilitate people's everyday actions such as their ability to move, communicate, and see better than before. Ultimately, it transforms lives.

There is also a clear economic case for improving access. Research shows investment in four products - hearing aids, prosthetics, eyeglasses and wheelchairs - will result in a return on investment of 9:1. For a child in a low- or middle-income country, access to assistive technology can also help them increase their lifetime income by US\$100,000. [dollar emoji]
